SUBJECT: CVMA Policy on Motorcycle Definition (Revision C)

1. The purpose of this policy is to define the motorcycle requirement for membership in the Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association® (CVMA®). This policy aims to ensure that all CVMA members meet the necessary requirements per current bylaws.
2. Definition: A qualifying motorcycle is defined as a vehicle meeting the following requirements.
 - a. Powered two or three-wheel vehicle where the driver sits astride the seat and steers via a handlebar.
 - b. Must have an engine of 500cc or above.
 - c. Must be registered for street use.
 - d. Must possess valid registration.
 - e. Must be covered by the minimum insurance requirements as mandated by State laws and regulations.
 - f. Overseas members must follow local laws for registration and insurance in accordance with their host country.
3. Trikes must include:
 - a. Either dual rear or dual front wheel configurations.
 - b. Same criteria listed above in 2(a.-f.).
4. Autocycles
 - a. Any member who joined using an autocycle as a qualifying motorcycle prior to December 11, 2016, is allowed to retain their membership
